Adults Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 1,703,266 adults between the ages of 18 and 59*. The population decreased by 3.0% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-21 to FY 2023-24, and a further decrease of 0.7% is projected from FY 2023-24 to FY 2026-27. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 3 adult residents of the County in June 2024.
