WHAT: Is human trafficking, exploitation and abuse, are the signs of child sexual grooming, it looks like in Orange County, are the resources of support for parents and caregivers to explore.

HOW: It can happen to any child with internet access, to talk to children about body safety and prevent and respond to sexual abuse, to assess workplace and job safety under U.S. labor laws.
