a) Legislative Updates – Kristina Traw

4. General Committee Member Comments

Betsy DeGarmoe, Orange County Department of Education shared that the Department of Ed. is addressing the needs of the community through the Local Control Accountability Plan, which is a tool for community engagement in setting goals, developing a plan of action, and resources. Below are three broad goal areas: Engagement, Student Outcomes, Conditions of Learning.

- Engagement: Provide all students with motivating programs, course work, and opportunities where they feel respected, included socially and emotionally, and cared for both in and out of the classroom. Families, schools, and stakeholders work closely together to build a strong framework for student achievement and safe and supportive school climates.
- Student Outcomes: Provide all students with a continuum of services that address academic, behavioral, social-emotional, health, and well-being needs.
- Conditions of Learning: Provide all students with access to fully credentialed teachers, instructional materials that align with state standards, and facilities that are maintained in good repair so students have access to a broad course of study that includes the implementation of California State Standards
- Lisa Burke shared that the first Conditions of Children Community Forum had a great turnout.
