Q: *When should I complete this NYTD survey?*

A: The NYTD Survey should be completed within the time period in which you turn 19 years of age.

If you are turning 19 between:	You should complete the NYTD Survey between:
October 1, 2012 and March 31, 2013	October 1, 2012 and March 31, 2013
April 1, 2013 and September 30, 2013	April 1, 2013 and September 30, 2013

Q: *How do I collect my \$75.00 incentive payment?*

A: Your \$75.00 incentive payment will be mailed to your home address within 3-4 weeks after you've completed the survey.

You will have the opportunity to do this again in two years when you turn 21. Please keep us informed of any changes in your address, telephone numbers, and e-mail.
